**Sunday, June 30, 2013 9:30 – 1:00** **Beth Groundwater signs *Fatal Descent* at the South Pearl Street Farmers Market (in front of the Bell Studio Gallery, 1573 S. Pearl St.)**

Colorado author and outdoor enthusiast Beth Groundwater was an avid "river rat" in the 1980's and has enjoyed reacquainting herself with that sub-culture while researching her Rocky Mountain Adventures mystery series. This is the third book in that series, which features river ranger Mandy Tanner, who lives in Salida, CO and polices the Arkansas River. In this book Mandy Tanner is guiding a rafting trip on the Colorado River when a young man dies and everyone on the trip is a suspect.

Beth has written five mystery novels to date, including *A Real Basket Case*, which was a finalist for the Agatha Award for best first novel. Beth was also nominated for the "Rocky" award in 2012.

**Signed books available in June:** I will have signed copies of Craig Johnson's *The Serpent's Tooth* after June 27, 2013 and near the end of June I will have signed copies of *The Heist*, which is the first book in Janet Evanovich's new series, written with Lee Goldberg.

### Read and Recommended

I have read an awfully lot of great books in the last few months, so here is a sampling of those that I really enjoyed. Not every book will appeal to everyone so feel free to ask if you have questions about any of them. Obviously I have not read them all the books in the monthly lists in this newsletter -though I would like to- so there are many great reads not covered by these recommendations.

In the definitely cozy category is Nancy Atherton's new book *Aunt Dimity* and This series is always charming and entertaining and this book is no exception. I have a couple of signed copies. Also a good read is *The Frozen Shroud* by Martin Edwards. The characters, starting with Daniel Kind, a specialist in the history of murder, are complex and the remote Lake District setting is an intriguing part of the plot, which also has a satisfying number of red herrings and twists.

Still light-hearted is Marcia Clark's new book *Killer Ambitions* which is a legal thriller written from a humorous angle. There is also Tim Hallinan's third book in the Junior Bender series, *The Fame Thief*. In this book Junior has been "asked" by a very scary mob individual to solve a 70-year-old crime. The books are written in a noir style but are still fun and funny because of the sharp-witted main character, who is so real you feel like you've known him all your life. David Rosenfelt's new Andy Carpenter book *Unleashed* is clever and entertaining with the humorous dialog that we have come to expect from him. Andy always has the snappy comebacks that I wish I could come up with but never think of until days later...

Martin Walker is back with a new installment in the Bruno, Chief of Police series called *The Devil's Cave*, a terrific read set in the Perigord region of France. I always learn new things about the region, culture and wine and the mouth-watering descriptions of the meals Bruno makes for his friends make me wish I could actually cook!

I also loved the debut novel by Ingrid Thoft, *Loyalty*, which features Fina Ludlow, a tough woman PI, who works for her family's personal injury law firm but who is not afraid to challenge her father and brother's sometimes questionable ethics and business involvements. I hope there are more in this series.

Moving on to the darker side, I can heartily recommend Paul Dieron's *Massacre Pond*. Dark and violent with a complex plot, I could not put this well-written book down. I also read Jussi Adler-Olson's newest *A Conspiracy of Faith* - I liked it so much I reread the previous two books, *The Keeper of Lost Causes* and *The Absent One*. These are psychological thrillers with truly chilling plots and themes, but with characters whose twisted humor and weird interactions relieve the tension at just the right times.
